Henri Matisse set out to become a lawyer and attended law school. As luck would have it, became ill and was put on bedrest. He was given art supplies as he recovered and realized at age 20, he wanted to be an artist. He participated in “fauvism” which regarded color as a structural element,

denouncing green meant grass and blue meant sky. Matisse then began “painting with scissors” introducing organic elements and working more with paper as a collage artist.
